20 Years of Ministry



The Reverend Dr. Lawrence and Mrs. Lisa Lacher of Roxana Church, after 20 years of faithful and fruitful ministerial service to Roxana Church, the Illinois District, and the surrounding communities, accepted a call to Roswell First Church of the Nazarene, in New Mexico. As Pastor Larry said in his final report, "We have done a lot of life together in 20 years." And the numbers are impressive: 100 funerals, 80 weddings, 108 baptisms, 242 people received into membership,

53 baby dedications, 56 people placed on the memorial roll, and 21 Distinguished Service Awards given to folks who have exemplified service to the church. DSA number 22 came as a total surprise as the church recognized Pastor Larry and Lisa's accomplishments during their ministry that spanned 20 years of loving people.

Pastor Larry served the community that surrounds the church wearing a variety of hats: serving on the Roxana Board of Education, the Roxana Schools Foundation Board, East Alton Rotary Club, and the Wood River Township Ministerial Alliance.

Dr. Larry also served the Illinois District with distinction on the Camp Board, Board of Ministerial Studies, Board of Ministerial Credentials, District Advisory Board, and developed the District Ministerial Mentoring Program and the District School of Ministry, and was a member of the Olivet Board of Trustees. This is just a small snapshot of Pastor Larry and Lisa's years of service to the church, community and denomination.

Their greatest ministry across these 20 years has been with the people they have shepherded. Pastor Larry and Lisa have labored among the congregation in

love, steadfast in hope, always mentoring before the flock what it means to be Christ-like. They have been instrumental in guiding folks towards growth in the grace and knowledge of our Lord, Jesus Christ and modeled what it means to have a servant's heart. And we, the people of Roxana Nazarene Church, are spiritually richer because of them.



We said our good-byes to Pastor Larry and Lisa at a dinner on April 6 with more than 200 people in attendance, including their three children and their families. The church gifted them with hundreds of cards filled with love and God's blessings, a Wesley bust for Pastor's office, and a basket filled with kitchen goodies for Lisa. Their first Sunday in Roswell was April 27. May God richly bless their ministry there!
