Camp Lice Guidelines and Form (Church Form)

Since contagious medical conditions can be a major problem at a summer camp, we regret that children who have acquired head lice, may not attend. Since head lice is the most common contagious issue camps generally encounters, the following applies to every child/camper. All campers must be checked for head lice, nits and eggs before the registration/check-in process. If this form is not competed, campers will have to be checked by a designated individual at the campgrounds.

We ask that you please do a lice check at your church before leaving for Camp. The check must be completed by a qualified person—licensed cosmetologist, nurse, nurse practitioner, physician assistant, physician, or another health care professional.

Please complete the list below with each child's name. Have that qualified person sign as to each child being free of lice. This final check MUST be done no MORE THAN 24 hours prior to camp. (An initial check may also be encouraged a few weeks prior to camp so treatment can be given if needed. We do not want ANY child to miss out on camp!)
